During the last couple of COVID years the club received great assistance from the West Torrens Council, which contributed significantly to our profit, by providing relief from expenses we normally incur; for example, lease/rates, electricity, water, some repairs & maintenance.

Their generous assistance has now ceased and we are back to meeting these costs. Financially things are heading in the right direction for this financial year. Events like our Grand Classic, the Festival of Bowls, Country Women's Round Robin are all important income generators for us. Your support and help to our organisers of these events is vital for them to be a success.

During the non-pennant months, as you would expect, club expenses exceed our income. Now that the pennant season is under way our income has increased and exceeds our expenses, but we have some catching up to do. This is the normal cycle each year.

Bar Staff

Your help is greatly appreciated. The club could not operate without you. THANK YOU.

A couple of points that will make the "Financial Team's" job a little easier.

Each week we have to differentiate between bar sales and non-bar sales for accounting and management purposes.

So ... to clarify:

All items held in the bar (e.g. drinks, caps, Grippo, Toucha, snacks etc) and sold should be rung up on the till as either EFTPOS or cash.

For EFTPOS sales that are not bar stock (e.g. uniforms, club fees, tournament fees, food sold through the kitchen, etc) please note what the sale was for, and by whom, on the EFTPOS slip we keep e.g. "Smith Hoodie"

If the EFTPOS sale was for food and drinks note the food component on the slip e.g. "Food \$15.75".

I know things get extremely hectic behind the bar and you'll do the best you can.

- All refundable bottles must be <u>separated</u> into **green, brown & clear** and placed into the separate respective wheelie bins along the badminton wall.
- EMPTIES ARE NOT TO BE DUMPED INDISCRIMINATELY.

Failure to follow these simple "rules" results in our volunteer(s) spending Sunday mornings tipping out the bins and sifting through broken glass to sort out the mess.

Please be assured that if these rules can't be followed, bottled beers will not be purchased ... i.e. we will become a "cans only" club.

It is not a difficult job to separate the empties and only takes a few minutes more than dumping them.



Duty Rink Tasks

Before the game

- 1. Raise the three flags
- 2. Set up the electronic scoreboards using the extension cords kept in the storeroom
- 3. Place jacks & mats at the end of the allocated rinks
- 4. Wipe down all seating adjacent to the green(s) of the day
- 5. Roll shade covers across the green seating
- 6. Check & empty all rubbish bins
- 7. Fill the urn and switch on
- 8. Place wind flags on the green(s) of the day
- 9. Place money pouches & table numbers (stored in linen cupboard)
- 10. Place measuring equipment "sack-truck" adjacent to green(s) of the day

After the game

The following tasks should not be undertaken until your direct opponents have departed the club, i.e. these tasks should not be done while you still have visiting bowlers to socialise with.

- 1. Lower the flags and return to storeroom
- 2. Gather the green wind flags & return to the storeroom
- Power down the scoreboard, cover with hoods & return power cords to storeroom
- 4. Return all mats & jacks to the storage trolleys and return them to the southwestern corner of the main hall
- 5. Empty all bins
- Retract & secure all shade covers ... if you need help, ask a tall person
