From the President (by Sam Katsivas)

Pennant Season

As the pennant season approaches, we are looking to consolidate our plans for on-field success again this season. Individuals have invested heavily with time to strategically plan the way forward to ensure success in every competition and at every level of pennants this year. From the Sunday clinics which I know have taken Brad over 100 hours just for the planning phase and a non-negotiable time commitment that has been required from the premier squad to assist with the delivery; to the one-to-one sessions with members who have requested assistance; and yet still more programs to come, the vision is to broaden the culture of pennant success throughout the entire club.

We all feel disappointment if selection outcomes do not meet our own expectations. The measure of whether we are true club people is how we deal with that disappointment. Our club selection policies are merit-based using two major criteria. The first is around ability and form. The second is around potential for growth and improvement. This may mean that a bowler who is young, raw and inexperienced may be promoted ahead of a consistent, solid and respected bowler who has attained the pinnacle of their abilities, particularly if the assessment made by the selection panel is that the new bowler has potential for quick improvement and will in time provide long, sustained quality bowling results for the club.

I ask you all not to make the mistake of measuring success by where you are selected. Measure your success by the ideals that have been offered to us through the development clinic. Am I reaching my potential? Am I training to improve my areas of weakness? Am I supporting my fellow rink and team members to help them reach their potential? Am I showing interest in all the other divisions and players in our club? Am I a team player or an individual?

These are questions that transcend all sports and team endeavours, not just lawn bowls. Ask them of yourself and then answer truthfully. Your answers may surprise you.

Talks between Lockleys and Grange Bowling Clubs are in their infancy, but they are being seriously conducted and are very encouraging. As directed by our members, a signed MOU will be required before we consider a joint-venture partner. Watch this space.
