From the President (by Sam Katsivas)

Redevelopment

As you would have read in the recent email sent out by both presidents to their respective members, a formal agreement has been signed by both clubs expressing their interest and intent in working together to create a new facility at Lockleys where Lockleys Bowling Club and Grange Bowling Club will continue and re-locate their operations respectively.

We will be two separate clubs under the one roof, each club retaining its uniform, identity and history. That is now official.

We now need to shift our focus to getting the best outcome and spend for our money in the realisation of a project that will be the envy of every bowler in this state.

Securing additional funding from state and federal bodies is critical to the final quality and feature build of our facility, so we will now engage with Bowls SA to seek their co-operation in lobbying state and federal politics to ensure we secure the level of funding that we require to build the Centre of Excellence.

We already have a financial commitment from West Torrens City Council and Grange Bowling Club and we could build a centre in our own right using those funds alone – however, with additional funding from a number of bodies with vested interests in promoting our sport at a high level in this state, the facility can be greatly enhanced.

In terms of management tasks, there is a lot to be done. In the initial stages of the project, we need to put in place a consultation process to give members a voice in expressing their wishes for what requirements and features we will need in a new centre. That will be done as soon as

possible, but not until the new year (to allow for council to reform their ministries after the election).

Council will need to sign off on the new partnership as well as conduct their own consultation process with the residents in the immediate vicinity as well as with the building consultants who have been engaged to scope the project.

I know the burning question from members will be “when will this happen?” but until a few of those preliminary tasks are completed I don’t have a definitive answer. I can say for certainty though that the process will be quicker than the original scenario where the South Road development and the Crows development were going to impact on our timelines. That is no longer an impediment. Certainly, as president, I will give you the undertaking that I will drive the project to proceed at full steam ahead, and not to stagnate. And I will inform you about proposed timelines as soon as I know what they are.

In terms of discussion with other clubs, as I mentioned in the recent email, you can now confidently inform inquisitive souls around the bowls community that Grange and Lockleys will be co-locating at Lockleys BC within their own identity, sometime in the near future, as the members of both clubs have endorsed this through the signing of an MOU.

This is a real step forward as it provides some certainty for the first time since negotiations began five years ago. Again, and as always, I thank our members and our board for supporting these initiatives and enabling our working party to stay strong and focussed in delivering great outcomes for our club.
