I have good news for members. I have received official confirmation that the West Torrens Council has voted to support our request to build a new facility for the Lockleys and Grange Bowling Clubs at 46 Rutland Avenue, Lockleys.

Together with council and the support of Bowls SA, this now provides a level of certainty which enables council to initiate the next set of its processes which are necessary for the project to commence. As importantly, it enables both clubs to move forward also confidently, with targeted planning for the future. **This is a great day for both our clubs.**

Women's Country Round Robin

This event was a great success and the hard yards put in by all the volunteers paid dividends – both financially and for the club's reputation.

Our expenses were a little more this year, a reflection of rising costs.

2022 – Income \$11,840.05, Expenses \$3,762.61, Bar Trade \$3,319.15

2023 – Income \$11,792.20, Expenses \$4,338.97, Bar Trade \$6,418.00

Bar & EFTPOS

We now have a second & more modern EFTPOS machine for use at the club.

Our existing unit has also been replaced soon for a newer model. The second unit is making things easier for bar staff reducing the need to wait for the one machine to become available. We do pay a monthly fee for these units (\$85 for our existing unit and \$55 for the new one, which is on a smaller monthly plan).

There is frequently a discrepancy between our cash register total for EFTPOS sales and the actual figure on our bank statement.

Recent examples Cash register Total \$391.00, Bank Statement \$297.50.

Cash register Total \$87.00, Bank Statement \$149.50

If the Cash button is pressed when it's an EFTPOS sale or vice versa it can lead to these discrepancies.

I realise that bar staff can be under pressure with thirsty bowlers queuing for a drink; but I would ask you to take just a second or two longer processing an EFTPOS transaction for greater accuracy. It will be a great help!!

I maintain the club membership database and also produce the Membership Phone List. Could you advise me if any of your details change.


To ensure our records are current, could you advise me if you hold any of the following accreditations and any expiry date.
