As the new season unfolds, there will be many events approaching so please keep your ears and eyes open so that you do not miss out on important news and happenings around the club, especially during the coming weeks as we count down towards season launch.

Season Launch Event ... 19 September

At our season launch event on **Tuesday evening 19th September** where we will welcome our existing members and induct our new ones, I will make available and speak about the **"Three Pillars of Success"** document which has been developed in response to the need to identify what we stand for as a club and where we see our pathways for future success.

Selectors

The most recent Bowls Committee meeting ratified the selection group for the coming season. The group will be led by Chair of Selectors Chris Flavel.

Selectors David Aust, Jorge Regidor-Yanez, Lyal Mutton, Darryl Rebbeck and Bob Winen will have primary responsibility for selection of Saturday and Wednesday sides, whilst Sue Coultas and Joe Ziniak will have primary responsibility for Thursday selections.

To make the selection group complete, we would like someone from our **Saturday Division 6** team to assist, so if you're able to help, please talk to Chris Flavel or myself.

Other pennant matters

We have nominated the same number of sides as last year ...
4 on Wednesday, 2 on Thursday and 5 on Saturday.

But, this season we have requested that our Wednesday and Saturday sides play half at home and half away each week.

With some teams playing at home each week, we hope this will encourage more players to return to the club after away games ... and we would like those playing at home to stay around until players from other teams return to the club.

At the most recent Board meeting, we endorsed the re-introduction of a "Lucky Members" draw to be held at 6.30pm each Saturday during the season.

• Changes to the Premier division competition this season will see the Premier side play 4 Friday night games, 2 Sunday afternoon games and 1 Saturday night game.

That means there will be seven Saturdays when the rest of the club is playing that the Premier side will not.

I am strongly encouraging all pennant players to support other sides across the club and across the whole season. Premier side players to be supporting teams on their "free" Saturdays and I hope that players from the other teams will support the Premier side when they're playing at those other times.

Player Development

We kicked off the Winter Clinic last Friday and Saturday morning and over twenty members attended one of the sessions. This will run for another four weeks.

Members who missed the sessions last week but who would like to take part are still welcome.

If you would like to attend, please be at the club by 9.45am on either Friday or Saturday.

Anthony Moffatt and I are running the Friday morning sessions, whilst Chris Flavel and Joe Ziniak are running the Saturday sessions. Stephen Jones is also providing support.

Anthony and I are also looking to continue Friday morning sessions beyond the five weeks and to have tailored development programs throughout the season.

Festival of Bowls

Lockleys will host the Festival of Bowls in early January. Proposed dates are Thursday 4-Jan, Friday 5-Jan and Sunday 7-Jan. There is a Premier pennant game scheduled for 6-Jan although other grades don't play until the 13-Jan.

We will be nominating at least two teams for the Club Super Challenge which will commence on Sunday 12 November. A list will be on the notice board for you to express your interest.
