# Membership Report (from Lyal Mutton)

#### **New Members**

If you Google "Bowling clubs SA" it gives the outside world's perception of our club.

Lockleys has now made it to the first page of search results but is the third lowest rated bowling club in SA out of 50 clubs at 3.9 out of 5.

So members need to add positive google reviews during the season, so people looking for a club see us as their preferred destination. A procedure will be developed that you can follow to achieve this.

# **Retention of Members**

Key to this is communications to the membership to keep them abreast of what's happening at the Club.

The challenge is to ensure that the communication process reaches the intended audiences in a timely manner and the platforms are kept up to date and relevant.

Currently, Lockleys Bowling Club uses the following platforms to store club data and communicate with its members and the general public.


