From the President (by Sam Katsivas)

Food Preparation Legislation

New government legislation requires that anyone who cooks or prepares food for others needs to have undertaken a course in safe food handling. In addition, organisations who do this on a regular basis (like us) are required to appoint a **Food Supervisor** to oversee all operations involving the safe handling of food. This will be monitored and policed by our local council.

Organizations and Clubs need to be compliant under this legislation by **December 8th, 2023**.

What does this mean for our club?

Karen Bishop, your Vice-President has been appointed as our club's Food Supervisor by the board. She has drawn up a list of our members who regularly perform duties in the kitchen and I will be contacting those people shortly to invite them to come to the club for a two-hour training session which will culminate in them being certificated as a safe food handler.

There is a "Do Food Safely" online course which our food preparers will complete, but it can be done by anyone if you want to have a go at it at your own leisure.

Working Bee >> Sunday 17 December

I am proposing that we run a working bee at the club on **Sunday 17th December (10.00am to 1.00pm)**.

The purpose will be a general tidy-up and will be followed by a BBQ from 1-2pm.

Areas that need attention include the boardroom, the storerooms opposite the boardroom, the ladies' lounge and possibly the sheds, kitchen and cool room.

Ideally, we would have people who know those areas well, there to provide direction on what we keep and what we throw out. We would hire a large skip to be delivered to the car park on the Friday before and be picked up again the following Monday.

The club would put on a free BBQ lunch with one free drink from the bar for all helpers. Please put your name down on the list at the club if you are willing help us out for three hours on the 17th.

Saturday Dinners

These are now up and running with a loyal crew of kitchen cooks and helpers. The meals are substantial, as well as being very fresh and tasty so if you've not had the pleasure of experiencing a delicious meal at very reasonable prices with incredible company (ourselves), then do yourself a favour and try to get to the next one. You will not be disappointed.

I'd like to thank the people who have revived this initiative and volunteered their services to serve our members. Let's get behind them and support their efforts.

Reciprocal Bowling Rights

From time-to-time, people ask to use our greens for practice when they cannot get access to theirs (travelers, people passing through, people who work nearby and can't get to their own club etc).

The board's direction is that people who are members of their own club and want to come to our club to have a roll should be welcomed. **No player should ever be turned away** by any of our members (unless all greens are closed) and in fact if you happen to be there when someone arrives and requests a roll up, you should offer the hand of friendship and invite them in.

I know that some clubs charge a "greens fee" to visiting bowlers but that is not the policy of our club. If people want to use our greens for more regular, on-going practice they can be advised to write to the board requesting formal permission on a longer-term basis (which in most cases will be granted).

I do not want to hear of any person being asked to leave our club, simply because they are not a member.

AGM >> 19 May 2024

While we are a long way out from the date of our AGM, we have had a request from the MBA for Lockleys to host the MBA AGM on Sunday 26th May 2024 (all clubs get asked to do this on a rotational basis).

This would typically have been the date on which we hold our AGM, so I have checked with our Treasurer and auditor, and they are both comfortable with us running our AGM a week earlier on **19th May 2024**, so that we can accommodate MBA's request.

You will receive more notifications about these dates as we approach those events, but for those of you who like to receive early notification, please lock these dates in May in your calendars.

Night Owls

I would just like to remind pennant players who play Night Owls of the unwritten rule that there should be no more than one pennant player in a Night Owls team and that pennant player should play either as a lead or a two, not as a skipper.

We recently had a game where a new team played against a more experienced team which happened to have three pennant players, one of whom was the skipper. At the end of the 12-end game the score was 42-0.

Perhaps a better alternative might have been to mix and match players across both teams and offer some coaching to the new team along the way. Remember, Night Owls is a potential breeding ground for new pennant players, so we need to coach, encourage and support them to get better.

Sometimes You Win

A big thank you to **Theo, Tony and Glenn** who were all instrumental in getting the club a full refund of **\$2,738.90** for the outdoor seats we purchased last year (on the basis of them not being safe).

Several people went A over T when one side was vacated very quickly by all parties and the other side toppled over, complete with drinks, nibbles and three very surprised members who found themselves looking up at the clouds rather than across the greens).

Anyway, long story short, the company asked us for a video displaying how the benches were unsafe. The Lockleys Actors Guild rounded up a few thespians – Jonesy, Glenn, Michael Hogan, Doctor Dean who hammed up a most compelling performance. *Gone With the Wind* it wasn't but suffice to say, it resulted in a full refund and an offer for us not to return the seats – which the erstwhile Glenn Miles is now creating some post-fabrications to make the seats safe to use.

Thinking entrepreneurially, perhaps a new video can follow, which can be sent to the company with an offer for them to buy the patent ... although even I would admit that's probably a bridge which is a tad too far......

Anyway, well done all. Creativity and teamwork at its very best.

Over the last couple of months, we have purchased new equipment for the maintenance of our greens and verges.

Lawn Mower for verges >> \$1,300

New Greens Mower & Roller >> \$20,550

The Outdoor Tables were considered unsafe as they tipped over when users on one side got off the seat. I pursued the issue with the retailer and obtained a full refund of \$2,738.90. They did not want the seats returned, so we are keeping them and looking to overcome the tipping issue by securing them to the ground. A bonus for us!

We have several private Xmas functions coming up that will be profitable – a good return for the work our helpers put in to make these private functions possible. They are great boost to our finances. (e.g. the Friday night function on 10 November was outstanding and had bar takings of \$2,100).
