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## Facilities News (from Glenn Miles)

During February and March, the following work has been carried out around the club:-

- ❖ Constant overflow of water from our evaporative A/C system has been addressed by the council and hopefully the run-off on our rear gutters will now stop.
- ❖ Thanks to Sue Hogan for organizing through her contacts, we have had Test Tagging done on our electrical appliances and our fire extinguishers have been check for compliancy.
- ❖ Electric score boards are proving more difficult to read and we are now exploring options to revert to the normal manual systems.

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## Umpire's Corner (from Dean Broadbridge)

Helping you with some of the "Laws of the Sport of Bowls".

### Q1 .. What happens if a bowl, or the jack, rebounds from the bank back onto the rink?

If the bowl is not a toucher, it becomes a dead bowl, and any bowls disturbed by it are restored as near as possible to their original position by a member of the opposing team. A toucher and/or the jack, remain in play where they finish up and disturbances caused by them are legal and valid. If the jack rebounds to a position within the boundaries of the rink but less than 18m from the mat (in a straight line from the front centre of the mat to the jack) it is declared a dead end. (Law 19.1.3)

### Q2 .. What if I play one of my opponent's bowls by mistake?

Nothing happens - once at rest, mark its position and angle, replace it exactly with yours and return it to its owner. If it was a toucher the replacement bowl can also be marked as a toucher. (Law 29.2)

### Q3 .. What happens if I play before my turn?

If the bowl is on its way, the opposing Skip can stop it and return it to be played in the proper sequence. If it is not noticed until it comes to rest, providing it is (a) still "live" and (b) has not

disturbed the Head. The player, who should have played, plays 2 bowls in succession, to restore the proper sequence, If, however, it has disturbed the head, the opposing skip has 3 options: - (a) leave things as they are and have his/her player play two bowls in succession, or (b) replace the head to its original position and return the bowl to be re-played in its proper turn, or (c) declare the end dead.(Law 29.1)

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## WARNING ... read the following as if it were an April Fools' Joke

### Coaches Corner

The role of a coach goes much further than inducting new bowlers and giving advice to experienced players. Among many other things it is also concerned with advising members on etiquette and the ethics expected of them. The failure of members to conform to established standards can be very irritating to others. The problem is that most who engage in such behavior are not aware that their conduct is so evident.

**The rather light hearted and exaggerated scenario following is a sure fire method to follow if you are hell bent on irritating your skipper and the other members of your team.**

I'll bet you have all met some of the characters depicted.

#### Advice to the Lead

When you first meet your skip, tell him you only bowl one hand.

If you can bowl on both hands, change your hand from time to time without asking his permission.

If your opponent is holding shot and your skipper ask you to get one close, take no notice of him and have a little niggled at the shot bowl. You will upset him more if you lose your bowl in the process.

Don't look at him when he is trying to instruct you where to place the mat and always bowl the jack to the length you prefer, not to the length requested by him. Also, turn your back on him when he is endeavoring to align the jack.

#### Advice to the number Two

Don't take any notice of what went on between the leads so that when you get on the mat you can ask who is holding shot?

Always get your bowl away, preferably before your opponent's bowl has come to rest but in any event before the skip has instructed you on what he wants.

If he asks you to bowl to a particular position on a particular hand, tell him you would prefer to bowl to somewhere else on the other hand.

Never fail to have a niggle at opposing shot bowls, particularly when the skip asks you to draw to the jack.

If you miss and your bowl goes narrow taking out your team's second wood, explain to him that we needed some back bowls.

#### Advice to the Third

Immediately you get on the mat ask, "are we up or down?"

After the skip has instructed you on what he wants, go through every bowl in the head asking whose bowl it is.

When he asks you to draw the shot, always ask him if we have any bowls behind.

Develop a 'drive happy' mentality and always insist on it when down, particularly when you have only one bowl in the head.

Don't forget to tell the lead where to place the mat and the length needed.

After you have crossed over and the skip is about to bowl, tell him what you think he should do. Never wait for the skip to ask anything, just tell him.

Never leave any doubt in the skip's mind or in the mind of anyone else that you think you should be the skip.

If the skip is having a bad day, don't forget to mention it to the opposition team members, your own team, everyone on the adjoining rinks and of course the selectors. Your skip is sure to hear, This is good for team morale.

### Coaching Tip

Bob Monck of the Henley Beach Bowling Club is the first coach to take up our offer to publish a coaching tip. Bob is a Level 2 Coach, a long term Zone Coaching Coordinator and a RSABA Bowls Instructor. He offers the following advice on 'timing'.

"As the backswing commences and the bowl begins to drop, do not commence the forward step until the bowling arm reaches the knee. The lead foot takes a normal walking pace step and at the same time the non-bowling hand drops onto the thigh or knee to maintain balance.

Good timing is ensured if the downswing commences as the lead foot hits the ground. Keep at least 90% of your body weight on the front foot and deliver the bowl about 15 to 20 centimeters in front of it. The other knee should be tucked in behind the leading foot heel and a few centimeters, (5 to 10 according to your physical capabilities) above the ground."
